Old Testament Book Of Isaiah

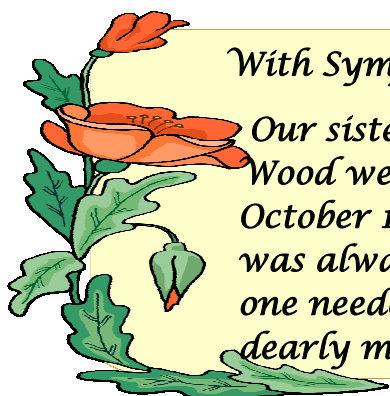

Thanks to all who came and supported our church at the “Harvest on the Square” celebration.

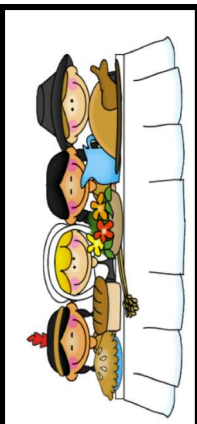
“Raise The Roof”

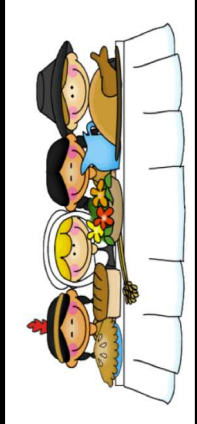


With Sympathy
